

Re-Established Economic Development Board Convenes in June

"The re-established Economic Development Advisory Board convenes June 5th. Comprised of business leaders and employers from industries across the County, each member of the board is uniquely positioned to help shape our economic development strategies and identify partnership opportunities." Among those appointed to the Board are a few names that may be familiar to our members including Dr. Valerie Sheares Ashby, President of UMBC, Aaron Miscenich, Executive Director of bwtech@UMBC, Nancy Hafford, Towson Chamber of Commerce, as well as noted economists Anirban Basu and Daraius Irani.

Members were appointed by County Executive Katherine Klaumeier and will serve a two-year term.

The purpose of the Board is stated as: "The Baltimore County Economic Development Advisory Board will provide input, as an advisory body to the County Executive's administration, on topics such as economic development, workforce development, tourism, arts and culture, housing and community redevelopment activities. Additionally, the Advisory Board will serve as a collaborative forum for partnerships between public and private elements of the local economy to be identified and developed."

Summer Scam Alert

While summer means many things to most of us – cook-outs, parades, vacations, it means something else to those with bad intentions. Summer is the time for scams, so be prepared.

- When working outside your home, keep other points of entry locked. For example, if gardening in the backyard, make sure the front door is closed and locked.
- Beware of door-to-door solicitations. If you didn't request an estimate for home improvement or utility work, don't allow "representatives" into your home or business. Don't show your utility bills to anyone unless you initiated the contact.
- Reputable contractors will be licensed and have insurance. Request a certificate of insurance before work starts.
- Know your rights before engaging with contractors, particularly those you don't know. The <u>Maryland Home Improvement</u> <u>Commission</u> licenses and regulates that industry.
